Job Summary:

New Hope Academy Physical Education teacher is responsible for planning and implementing physical activities, monitoring students, and evaluating student outcomes. He/She ensures the physical education curriculum promotes a physically active lifestyle; develops cooperation, teamwork, and sportsmanship; and provides ample opportunity for students to engage in regular physical activity that promotes normal growth and development.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Develop and implement engaging, standards-based lesson plans in health and physical education. (The National Standards for Physical Education, although not mandatory, can be used as a framework when developing a comprehensive physical education curriculum.)
- Demonstrate skills being taught; assist students in performing skills.
- Assess and evaluate student learning, growth, and progress towards fitness and health goals.
- Create and maintain a safe, positive, and inclusive learning environment conducive to the intellectual, physical, social, and emotional development of all students.

- Supervise students in PE space: outside on the blacktop or athletic fields, hallways, and in Foster Hall.
- Utilize school-wide responsive classroom management program following procedures of behavioral consequences and documentation.
- Communicate effectively with students, families, and colleagues
- Research and order physical education and recess equipment upon budget approval.
- Plan, organize, and coordinate field day; develop activities; set up for activities.
- Collaborate with other teachers and staff members to support student success and school-wide initiatives
- Participate in professional development opportunities to stay current with best practices and trends in health and physical education
- Attend NHA scheduled professional development opportunities
- Attend weekly faculty meetings
- Perform other related duties as required

- Ability to remain flexible with changes in routine or plans
